<u>ACCOMMODATIONS</u>: Each room has two single beds and a sink. If you need more than two single beds, please bring an air mattress or sleeping pad as Regina Mundi charges for extra mattresses. Washrooms and showers are shared. Bedding is supplied for beds. Bring your own towels, shampoo and soap. Campsites are also available (non-electrical). Free parking included.

**AMENITIES:** The venue has walking paths and bike trails. Babysitting is available. It's near a shopping area (City of Newmarket).

THINGS TO BRING: Bathing suits, towels and toys for water battle, bug spray, sun block, sun hats and sunglasses. Tea and water will be served with meals. If you like, bring some extra cold drinks to have on hand. Extra linens or sleeping bags (if using extra mattresses in rooms). Toys to share such as riding toys, toy vehicles, balls, sports equipment. Don't forget your camera for taking lots of great pictures!
